Building New Capabilities Through Industry Collaboration



Innovation often begins with overcoming technical challenges. For Applied Total Control Treatment (ATC), expanding into advanced surface finishing applications required addressing complex issues, including achieving reliable adhesion on ABS polymer surfaces and preparing its production line to support new manufacturing processes.

Working closely with SIMTech, ATC developed an advanced metallisation technique for polymers while undertaking extensive production line enhancements. The collaboration enabled the company to build new capabilities in polymer metallisation, complementing its existing expertise in metal plating and surface finishing.

The project has positioned ATC to capture new business opportunities across the aerospace and precision engineering sectors. The company expects to generate an additional S\$1 million in annual

revenue and has successfully delivered more than 8,000 repair trims to Singapore Airlines after becoming a qualified vendor. The collaboration also strengthened ATC's technical capabilities through knowledge transfer and training, while reinforcing the value of industry partnerships in driving innovation, operational excellence, and sustainable growth.
